#### Robert McGee

Good afternoon Board members it is an honor to address you today. I am here to address you today because I am also, as a citizen, I also have a dual role as the chair of a group called Ann Arbor Residents for Nonlethal Deer Management. I am sure all of you are aware that there is a culling activity that will be, actually is, occurring presently in the City of Ann Arbor. It's very contentious and I'm not going to bore you with all the pros and cons. The reason why I am here today is to let you know that Stapp Nature Area, which is, your library on Traverwood abuts, is in the culling zone. Culling shooting will start occurring at 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday and not on the weekends. There's concern that coincides with your office hours out there. Now besides the pro and con of the safety of it the State of Michigan

has a rule that says you may opt out like many residents are doing currently. I just submitted a package to the mayor and council and to the DNR that 9 out of the 23 parks residents of the parks have opted out by simply stating that they do not give permission for shooting to occur within 450 feet of their residence or place of business. Simple as that. Therefore, I am requesting that this board consider the safety of patrons at Traverwood Library and simply by board action opt out by stating that you do not give permission for shooting to occur within 450 feet of the building. That's all it would take. Thank you and I appreciate the time and I definitely appreciate the schedule because we've been scrambling on this. Josie told me you have a meeting today and so I took advantage and came. Thanks again, I appreciate it.

#### 16-005 V. DISCUSSION OF MICHIGAN SENATE BILL 0571

Trustee Leary, supported by Trustee Vander Broek, moved the Board adopt the following resolution

WHEREAS, the state legislature passed Senate Bill 571 which, among other things, prohibits local districts and other governmental entities from sharing information about their millages within 60 days of an election, and

WHEREAS, the sharing of information about millages is a responsibility of the district to help inform a citizenry about the facts around a millage, and

WHEREAS, citizens cannot make informed decisions without information from the governmental body that has placed the millage on the ballot, and

WHEREAS, public libraries and their governing boards have historically championed the right of free speech in America and Senate Bill 571 violates that right for all citizens in every election involving millage or bond questions, and

WHEREAS, the Ann Arbor District Library (AADL) is an independent governmental entity established under the laws of Michigan with its own taxation district, dedicated millage, and elected Board of Trustees;

#### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1.) The Ann Arbor District Library urges the governor to veto this legislation and return it to the state legislature for reconsideration.
- 2.) That all resolutions and parts of resolutions that conflict with the provisions of this resolution are rescinded.

#### Ann Arbor District Library Financial Summary for December 2015

#### Cash:

The unrestricted cash balance as of December 31, 2015 was \$14,435,275 down from \$15,394,678 in November.

#### Tax Receipts:

The Library has received tax receipts totaling \$12,490,314, 97.5% of the budgeted amount, as of December 31.

#### **Budget vs. Actual:**

The Library has a positive fund balance of \$8,563,179 as of December 31, up from \$8,420,000 at the end of November.

#### Year-to-Date Revenue (Budget vs. Actual):

Tax, state aid and penal fine revenues are being recognized monthly at the monthly budgeted amount. These line items will be reconciled with actual receipts during year-end close.

#### Year-to-Date Expenditures (Budget vs. Actual):

The following operating expense line items are over budget through December.

<u>Purchased Services</u> – Payment for landscape architectural services and the fixed asset physical inventory paid in November put this item over budget year to date.

<u>Communications</u> – The annual payment for internet connectivity paid in September put this item over budget year-to-date.

<u>Materials</u> – Annual online and print subscriptions and additions to the tools collection put this item over budget year-to-date.

<u>Software</u> – A large renewal payment for cataloging software paid in July and software license agreements paid in September put this item over budget year-to-date.

<u>Grants / Memorials</u> – Game prizes and promotional materials paid in August put this item over budget year-to-date.

<u>Supplies</u> – Supplies purchased to outfit the Secret Lab put this item over budget year-to-date.

<u>Repairs and Maintenance</u> – Charges for moving materials out of the Westgate branch were paid in December.

<u>Capital Outlays</u> – Payments for elevator remodel, furniture and staircase carpet put this item over budget year-to-date.
