Ann Arbor District Library Financial Summary for July 2015

Cash:

The unrestricted cash balance as of July 31, 2015 was \$8,603,290 up from \$8,084,025 in June.

Tax Receipts:

The Library has received tax receipts totaling \$1,646,912, 12.9% of the budgeted amount, as of July 31.

Budget vs. Actual:

The Library showed an operating deficit of \$73,450 through July 31. This gives the Library a positive fund balance of \$8,261,330 as of July 31, down from \$8,588,462 at the end of June.

Year-to-Date Revenue (Budget vs. Actual):

Tax, state aid and penal fine revenues are being recognized monthly at the monthly budgeted amount. These line items will be reconciled with actual receipts during year-end close.

Year-to-Date Expenditures (Budget vs. Actual):

The following operating expense line items are over budget through July.

Employment Costs – The merit increases took effect and were paid in July.

Software – An annual renewal payment for cataloging software was paid in July.

<u>Grants / Memorials</u> – Summer game prizes and promotional materials were paid in July.

<u>Supplies</u> – The purchase of computer screens for the training center in July put this line item slightly over budget.

Repairs and Maintenance – The quarterly payment for the HVAC maintenance contract was paid in July.

Other Operating Expenditures – Annual membership dues were paid in July.

<u>Capital Outlays</u> – Large payments for construction of the front entry were paid in July.
