Ann Arbor District Library Financial Summary for November 2009

Cash:

The unrestricted cash balance as of November 30, 2009 was \$13,551,206 down from \$14,316,088 in October.

Tax Receipts:

The Library has received tax receipts totaling \$11,085,055, 95% of the budgeted amount, as of November 30th.

Budget vs. Actual:

The Library showed an operating surplus of \$118,885 through November 30th. This gives the Library a positive fund balance of \$7,004,160 at the end of October, up from \$6,987,014 in October.

Year-to-Date Revenue (Budget vs. Actual):

Tax and penal fine revenues are being recognized monthly at the monthly budgeted amount. This line item will be reconciled with actual receipts at the end of the year.

Year-to-Date Expenditures (Budget vs. Actual):

The following operating expense line items, all of which should fall back into line later in the year, are over budget through November:

Salaries, Wages and Taxes – Lump sum payments for merit increases were paid in July.

<u>Custodial</u> – Carpet and window cleaning took place in July.

<u>Purchased Services</u> - An annual payment of approximately \$40,000 for OCLC was made in July.

<u>Communications</u> – A payment for internet access was made in October.

<u>Software Licenses</u> – A large payment of approximately \$60,000 was made in July putting this line item over budget.
