# Ann Arbor District Library Financial Summary for January 2011

## Cash:

The unrestricted cash balance as of January 31, 2011 was \$11,825,091 down from \$12,695,934 in December.

# Tax Receipts:

The Library has received tax receipts totaling \$10,886,651 96% of the budgeted amount, as of January 31st.

# **Budget vs. Actual:**

The Library showed an operating surplus of \$233,063 through January 31st. This gives the Library a positive fund balance of \$7,789,984 at the end of January, down from \$7,852,051 in December.

# Year-to-Date Revenue (Budget vs. Actual):

Tax and penal fine revenues are being recognized monthly at the monthly budgeted amount. This line item will be reconciled with actual receipts at the end of the year.

# Year-to-Date Expenditures (Budget vs. Actual):

The following operating expense line items, all of which should fall back into line later in the year, are over budget through January:

Employee Benefits – This reflects the increases in healthcare costs that became effective on July 1<sup>st</sup>. We are currently implementing cost saving measures that should turn this variance around in the second half of the year.

<u>Legal</u> - Large bills were paid in January for two ongoing legal issues.

<u>Purchased Services</u> – A large payment for cataloging and inter-library loan was made in September.

<u>Software Licenses</u> – A large payment of approximately \$60,000 was made in July putting this line item over budget.

Repairs and Maintenance – Quarterly maintenance invoices for the HVAC systems were made in January.

- Associate Director of IT and Development, Eli Neiburger has been invited, through AADL's prior work with the State Department, to participate in the US Embassy in Rome's Spring Event for Italian Librarians. This event will focus on "e-books, e-readers, tablets, and their relevance and implications for readers, publishers, authors, and especially for libraries." The event is March 31st at the Hotel Aldrovandi in Rome, and Eli will deliver his presentation online from Ann Arbor.
- 2. On Sunday, January 30, 2011, in partnership with Success by Six, Child Care Network and UM Work/Life Resource Center, AADL hosted the second Preschool Expo, the only large-scale event of this type in the Ann Arbor Area. Over 350 community members took advantage of the opportunity to conduct one-stop shopping for quality preschool environments with 42 preschools represented. The expo was held on the UM campus at Palmer Commons.
- 3. The AADL invites every second grade classroom in the Ann Arbor Public School system to visit the Downtown Library each year as part of our "Second Grade Roundup". The Friends of AADL fund the transportation costs and this year all 59 of the classes will have visited by June 2011. The chart below indicates how many classes participated in the fall when efforts are concentrated on this program. If a child does not already have an AADL card by age 7, and many do, this program gives them and their families an opportunity to apply for cards, see the youth department and meet library staff for a tour and storytime.
