- 2. Maximum time for individual speakers will not exceed three minutes.
- 3. One speaker may yield his/her time to another if both have signed up and both are in attendance at the meeting.
- 4. No person may speak more than once on the same subject during a single meeting.
- Citizens' Comments at special meetings or study sessions will occur at the end of the meeting. Maximum time for individual speakers will not exceed three minutes.
- 6. Trustees, Director, and Administrators will not answer questions during Citizens' Comments. The speaker may request a response in writing. Trustees may, with the permission of the Board President, ask a question of a speaker. No dialog will occur.
- 7. Individuals addressing the Board should take into consideration rules of common courtesy.
