On Friday, October 30th, AADL will participate in the Downtown Ann Arbor Treat Parade for young children.

Director Parker thanked all staff who assisted and presented at Staff Day.

Director Parker reported responses to the expansion of the West Branch Library have been tremendous. She noted requests for providing drive-up return service at this location have been received and while ideal, are not physically possible due to the configuration of the building. Walk up book returns will be located at both entrances to the expanded branch. The request for drop boxes remaining at the Westgate location when the branch is closed for expansion cannot be accommodated. The amount of material returned daily exceeds the capacity of the drop boxes and would require constant monitoring and removal of material. Her hope is that patrons will return materials where they retrieve them.

President Barney Newman reported she had attended Staff Day and was "blown away". Presentations and staff engagement were fantastic.

Director Parker finished her report noting the keynote speaker on Staff Day was Dr. Swift, Ann Arbor Public Schools Superintendent.

Secretary Kaplan inquired of providing FAQ's in response to West Branch inquires on the website. Director Parker responded that that could be done.

Ann Arbor District Library Financial Summary for October 2015

Cash:

The unrestricted cash balance as of October 31, 2015 was \$16,287,627 down from \$16,326,880 in September.

Tax Receipts:

The Library has received tax receipts totaling \$12,339,726, 96.4% of the budgeted amount, as of October 31.

Budget vs. Actual:

The Library has a positive fund balance of \$8,387,622 as of October 31, up from \$8,143,248 at the end of September.

Year-to-Date Revenue (Budget vs. Actual):

Tax, state aid and penal fine revenues are being recognized monthly at the monthly budgeted amount. These line items will be reconciled with actual receipts during year-end close.

Year-to-Date Expenditures (Budget vs. Actual):

The following operating expense line items are over budget through October.

<u>Communications</u> – The annual payment for internet connectivity paid in September put this item over budget year-to-date.

<u>Materials</u> – Annual online subscriptions paid in September and additions to the tools collection put this item over budget year-to-date.

<u>Software</u> – A large renewal payment for cataloging software paid in July and software license agreements paid in September put this item over budget year-to-date.

<u>Grants / Memorials</u> – Summer game prizes and promotional materials paid in August put this item over budget year-to-date.

 $\underline{\text{Supplies}}$ – Supplies purchased to outfit the Secret Lab purchased in September and October put this item over budget year-to-date.

Repairs and Maintenance – The quarterly payment for the HVAC maintenance contract paid in October put this item over budget year-to-date.

Other Operating Expenditures – Annual membership dues paid in July put this item slightly over budget year-to-date.

<u>Capital Outlays</u> – Final payments for construction of the front entry and Secret Lab paid in September put this item over budget year-to-date.
