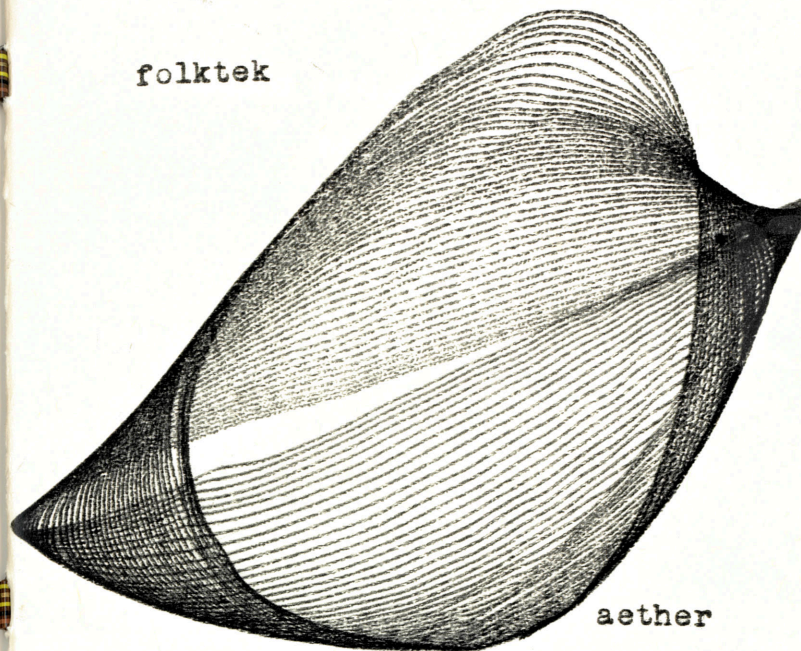

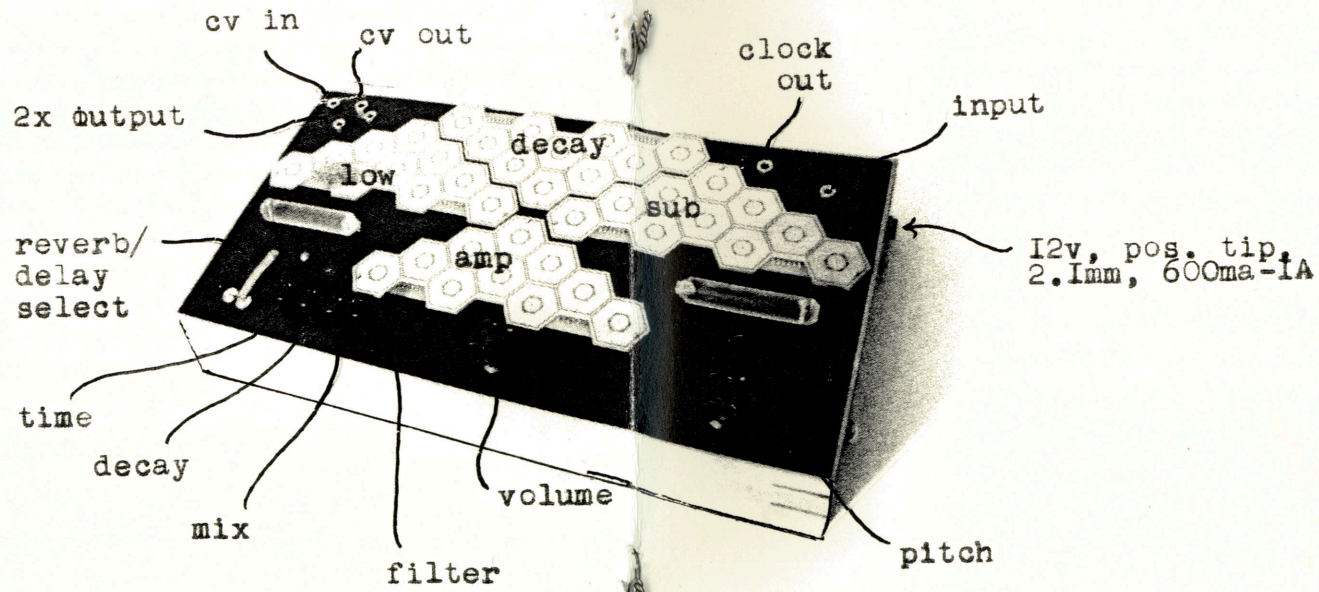

first, understand that Aether is inherently noisy tonally due to the exposed osc. pads. Filter noise with wet delay or reverb and filter knob as desired.

Four touch plates represent osc. and touch amplification. Touch amp works with "low". Sub is a "silent" osc. which provides texture to the others similar to the way an LFO works. However, full oscillation can be achieved by touching "sub" pads in conjunction with "amp".

"decay" sends CV

"clock out" divides internal frequency for synch.



- playability is simple.
- power up (lamps will light)
- adjust volume, pitch and delay/
reverb levels, touch plates
and enjoy
- further enhanced by Material Mental
and future additions.

- CV input auto detects CV and turns
pitch internal off.
- both outputs serve differing
function; wet and dry divide.
