Gentlemen—Your committee, to whom was referred, for investigation, the condition of the sidewalk and area walls under the sidewalk on the south side of East Liberty street adjoining the German-American Bank building, respectfully report that we examined the said sidewalk and area walls under the sidewalk and we find it in an unsafe condition, and we further find that the city is in no way to blame for the breaking or caving of the area wall, and we therefore recommend that the said sidewalk and area walls be repaired and put in a safe condition within fifteen days from the service of notice upon the owners of said premises by the Board of Public Works, as provided in the city ordinance.
