Sec. 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons being the owner or owners, possessor or possessors. or person or persons having in charge or care any domesticated rabbits, hares or chickens, ducks, geese other poultry, to permit or allow any of the same to go at large at any time within the limits of said city, or to keep, park or harbor any domesticated rabbits, hares or chickens,ducks,geese or other poultry within two hundred feet of any public or private hospital or school house with-in the said city of Ann Arbor, to the damage or annoyance of any of its inhabitants.

This ordinance shall take effect

after legal publication.
