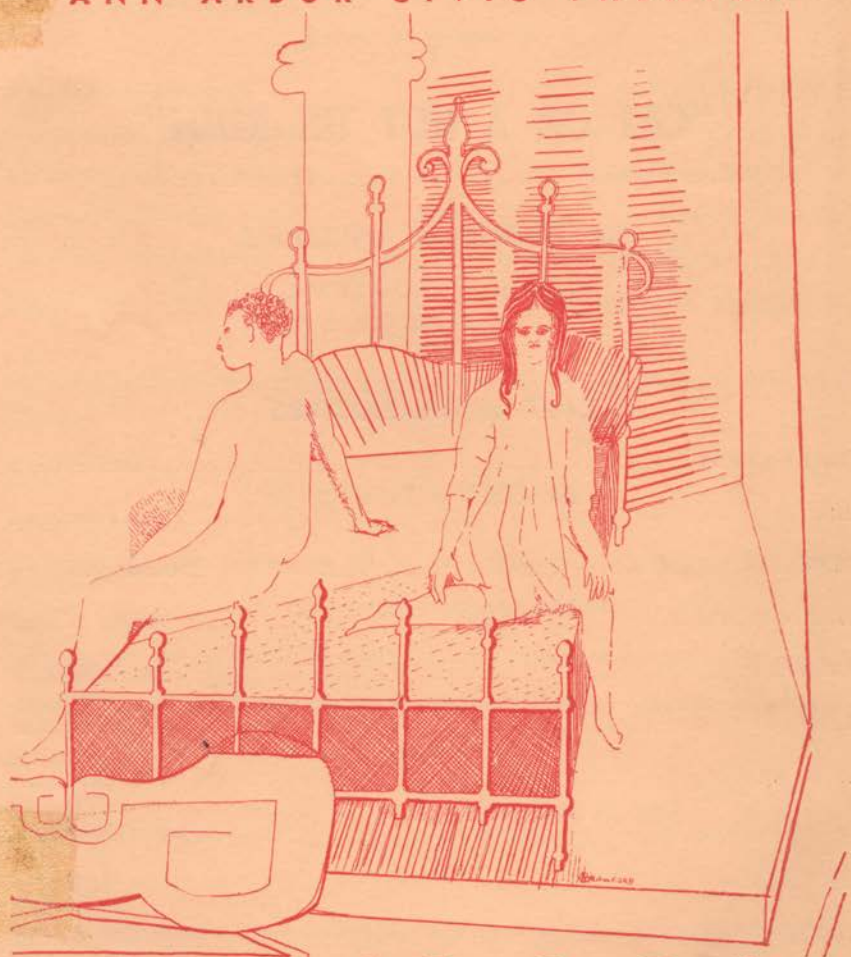

J. HENRY OWENS . . . head of the Foreign Language Dept. at Eastern Michigan College, has appeared in CT's "Bus Stop" and "Hatful of Rain". Also has played with the DAC and the Ypsilanti Players.

JOHN RAE . . . current Civic Theatre President, was last seen this season in "Visit to a Small Planet" and "Julius Caesar". This is his eighth CT appearance.

DAVE SELLARDS . . . a long-time favorite, and a past C-T President, was last seen in "Mia Mine."

BILL KUEHN . . . appearing for the first time on our stage, is the regular Master of Ceremonies for the Moose Prospect Night and is a former State Supreme Governor of the Loyal Order of the Moose.

NANCY RAE . . . a cheerleader at Slawson Junior High, making her stage debut, is a daughter of our president.
