



#### ABOUT THE CAST AND STAFF

PRESLEY ALEXANDER (Chowsey) makes his stage debut in GYPSY. Presley prepared for his first stage role by having his eyes "tucked." He resides in Ann Arbor with his mistress, Lisa Alexander, whom he loves very much, together with his "grandparents," Judy and Bob Alexander. He is part of a household which also includes a foster brother and sister who won't always play with him when the wants them to, and with a white cat he can never catch, no matter how hard he tries.

JUDY DOW-ALEXANDER (Madame Rose) and most of the "senior" cast walked on stage 22 years ago this December to present GYPSY. The difference is not just the passage of 22 years, but a whole lot of living, working, growing and changing. "The last time I did GYPSY my children were the ages my grandchildren are now." Judy would like to be remembered for lots of Gilbert and Sullivan; for a long list of musicals with AACT, especially HELLO DOLLY; for her years on WAAM radio; for teaching theatre at Greenhills; for some good times in NYC and traveling around the country; for Sweeney Todd; for Two Friends Among Friends with Constance Barron; and for her work with the Michigan Theatre, She looks forward to the Bernstein Mass in January, which will dedicate the Michigan and which will merge the talents of five of the major performing arts groups in Ann Arbor. Finally, she would like to dedicate her performance to her husband, who is always reaching out in support, and to her old friend Veitch Reinhart, who held her hand through the first GYPSY and is reaching out in spirit today.

LISA ANDRES (June) is playing in GYPSY for the third time although it is her first time with AACT. She has played the role of Dainty June in Dearborn and the Marquis Theatre in Northville. She has also played Lisel in SOUND OF MUSIC, Susie Hendricks in WAIT UNTIL DARK and Louise in CAROUSEL. She has also worked in several productions for Alexander Productions, has travelled with Sarah Paull Dance Company and has been in T.V. commercials. She is married and has two young children.

DAVID BARTH (L.A.) has had considerable stage experience, though still a high school student. Most recently he appeared as Snoopy in YOU'RE A GOOD MAN, CHARLIE BROWN in Saline. When not performing, he competes on the track and in swimming.

THAD A. BELL (Yonkers) has choreographed CAMELOT for the Chelsea Players, and has appeared in SEE HOW THEY RUN (Jackson), MEASURE FOR MEASURE (Grand Rapids) and many other shows. He taught a children's theatre workshop, and he loves comic books.

THOMAS COOCH (Tulsa) is well known to AACT audiences for his rolls in CHICAGO, BELLS ARE RINGING, GUYS AND DOLLS, THE LATE CHRISTOPHER BEAN, ONCE UPON A MATTRESS, KISS ME, KATE AND FOLLIES. In his spare time he collects coins. He pays for his hobbies by selling office supplies.

ALISANDE CUTLER (Co-Producer) has dabbled in just about every part of putting on a show except actually acting—and intends to keep it that way! "It's when it all finally comes together that makes it all worthwhile" she was heard to comment late one night after a rehearsal. "That excitement of the curtain going up after weeks of work can't be found many places."

BARBARA SMART DANIEL (Set Dresser) has done a little of everything theatrical starting as an usher, then chopping veggies for parties, a brief foray on stage in THE SOUND OF MUSIC, designed a poster or two and has been known to pick up a paint brush. Of all these pursuits, set decoration has given her the most satisfaction.

RICHARD EVANS (Lighting Designer) has acted as a set builder, set designer, consultant for difficult engineering type tasks and general shop handyman. He recently received his degree in electrical engineering from UM and is looking for a job. Call him for a resume.

SOPHIA FARAH (Makeup Designer) is a long-time, hard-working AACT member. She has worked in almost every area of theatre, and is best known for her coordination of the makeup for AACT and the UM operas. Sophia has assisted several other area theatre groups, taught workshops, and served on the AACT Board of Directors. She was on the makeup crew for AACT's 1964 GYPSY.

TOM FRANKS, JR. (Uncle Jocko, Announcer) appeared in AACT's SEVEN KEYS TO BALDPATE, ROYAL FAMILY, and PLAY WITH A TIGER; and in STATIONS OF THE CROSS and THE POTBOILER for the St. Andrew's Players. A philosophy professor at EMU, Tom serves on the AACT play selection committee and enjoys visiting NYC for even more theatre.

DAVID HARBISON (Kringelein) has worked with AACT on and off for 30 years. It is of special interest that he was Pastey in AACT's GYPSY 22 years ago; his sons Larry and George were newsboys.

TED HEFLEY (Pop) has worked with Eastern Michigan University and Ypsilanti Players. His most recent shows have been SOLID GOLD CADILLAC and MIRACLE WORKER. He is also in the May Festival Chorus. He is a professor of history at EMU.

ALICIA LYNN HOLBROOK (Baby June) couldn't resist trying out for AACT's GYPSY, even though she had just completed a run of the show at the Marquis Theatre in Northville. Her love of music keeps her busy with voice, piano, tap, ballet, and baton classes, and with entertaining many groups and organizations. She was 1985 Miss Southeastern Michigan Pre-Teen.

HELGA HOVER (Second Half Cow, Maid) has many years of experience on stage and back stage with AACT, including five years as a Board member. Her hobbies include competitive cross-country skiing and running.

JOHN JARRETT (Rehearsal Pianist and Orchestra) has appeared on stage or with the orchestra in many AACT shows, including THE APPLE TREE, HELLO DOLLY, FIDDLER ON THE ROOF, BELLS ARE RINGING, ROBBER BRIDEGROOM, and ANYTHING GOES. He is a member of the AACT Board of Directors and Treasurer. John recently flew to Boston to perform a concert of Gershwin music; and appeared at the Kerrytown Concert House in a concert of operetta music.

WENDY KEENEY (Props) is an Archeologist by training and a business owner at present. Wendy moved to Ann Arbor last year after spending 13 years in Saudi Arabia, Pakistan and Germany. She first started in theater in college, but became most actively involved in Jeddah, Saudi Arabia, where she worked backstage in the Jeddah Light Opera Society, Saudi Equity Theatre and Jeddah Players—resulting in at least one production per month! Wendy first joined AACT last summer when she did props for HAY FEVER.

KELLY LAMBERT (Louise) returns to the AACT stage after portraying "Winthrop" in the National Touring Company production of MUSIC MAN. Kelly enjoys deep-sea fishing, and is presently pursuing her doctorate in Structural Engineering at the Port Huron Institute of Architecture and Tent Awning Repair. (And she obviously enjoys writing fiction!)

ANDREW E. LIPPA (Music Director and Conductor) is a senior in music education at UM. He divides his time between his academic pursuits and the theatre, where he is a performer, music director and composer. Andrew most recently appeared as Frank Baily in the UM premiere of Sheldon Harnick's A WONDERFUL LIFE. He composed the music for Rachel Urist's SHTETL TALES and for the Young People's Theatre production of PUSS IN BOOTS. Other AACT credits include musical direction of BELLS ARE RINGING and ANYTHING GOES.

SHIRLEY MALLETTE (Co-Producer) wandered into AACT 3 years ago, picked up a paint brush and has been doing some area of production ever since. She has found all areas to her liking. This is her first try at producing, and she has picked it up like a native.

CONRAD MASON (Cigar) last appeared as Sir Evelyn Oakleigh in AACT's ANYTHING GOES. Twenty-two years ago he played the role of L.A. in AACT's first production of GYPSY. He also did the role of Marryin' Sam in LI'L ABNER for Dexter Community Players in 1985. Credits also include directing BLITHE SPIRIT and CURIOUS SAVAGE for Dexter Players. Currently he is President of the Board for Dexter Community Players.

LINN MATICH (Co-Designer, Builder) has been with Civic Theatre for five years and in that time has worked in many areas of production, including stage manager, builder, props, lights and running crew, and is also a Board member. Some day he would like to round out his experience by performing on stage.

RUNELDA MEDRANO (Assistant Director and Stage Manager) has a wealth of experience onstage and off. She appeared in OKLAHOMA and MAME, and has served as a member of the Board of Directors, secretary-treasurer, Spotlight editor and box office and membership chairperson.

GWENN ANGLE PROEGLER (Costume Designer) since joining AACT in 1980, has dressed five musical productions. Three of them, PIPPIN, HELLO DOLLY, and BELLS ARE RINGING have won "best of" awards in their season. Looking for a different challenge, Gwenn is serving as co-chairman of the CORNERBLOCKS and KEYSTONES fundraising drive for AACT during the 1986-87 season.

CAROL QUINNELL (First Half Cow) has appeared in several AACT shows, most recently BELLS ARE RINGING. She and Helga are enjoying re-creating the roles they played in AACT's 1964 GYPSY.

BOB REINHART (Pastey) is another returnee from AACT's original GYPSY (He played Herbie in 1964.). He also appeared in SOUTH PACIFIC, MAME, NEVER TOO LATE and CACTUS FLOWER and then took a break of 13 years before returning to this year's production. One of his major interests is in circuses. (That doesn't have anything to do with your interest in AACT does it, Bob?)

JUDI RICHARDSON (Agnes) first appeared with AACT in BLUES FOR MISTER CHARLIE last year. She studied drama and philosophy at the University of South Carolina. She enjoys traveling, attending sports events, dancing and just having fun.




