

DIRECTOR'S NOTE



No. this is not the play without sets. That's Thornton Wilder's OUR TOWN.

And no, this is not that show with Gene Kelly dancing his taps off in Times Square. That's ON THE TOWN,

This is the musical based on the book and play MY SISTER EILEEN. It's called WONDERFUL TOWN!

This point about titles apparently needs some clarification (much to the chagrin of some of us who remember WONDERFUL TOWN as the 4953 Tony winner). Apparently it is not well known to much of the audience who too young to get 10% off their restaurant bills, and Civic Theatre tickets.

In WONDERFUL TOWN! Bernstein took the opportunity to look back with a lot of affection at the diversity of the music he grew up with—and to treat it with just a bit of irreverence. He shows a great sense of humor, but a lousy sense of chronology.

The lyrics and stage directions set the show as 1935, but don't be fooled by that. This is definitely a 1950's musical in which Bernstein, Comden and Green cheerfully mix in a little bit of the 30's, a good deal of the 40's, along with some of the 50's.

The Swing number includes allusions to seven different records by such people as Louis Armstrong, Fats Waller, and Ella Fitzgerald. (Hazen Schumacher dug them out of the marvelous jazz library at the University and played them for me.) And you'll hear Irish jigs, boola-boola football songs and a host of other musical echoes from several decades, a crazy quilt pattern of songs and scenes.

As we have fried to do, please take your que from Bernstein. Join us in looking back from our not-so-lofty perch in the 80's and enjoy the music of our past. Enjoy it with affection, and like Bernstein, be sure to keep your tongue well planted in your cheek at all times.

This is WONDERFUL TOWN! Enjoy the show!



ABOUT THE CAST

GARY ADLER (Associate Editor/Shore Patrolman/Police-man/Villager) is new to AACT's stage, but he has been "theatrically inclined" for many years. While a student at U of M, he appeared in BABY and in the title role of DOONESBURY. Most recently, he was Music Director for MUSKET'S JESUS CHRIST SUPERSTAR, and YOU'RE A GOOD MAN, CHARLIE BROWN. In the future, he plans on taking his practical degree in plane performance to Philadelphia . . . And starving.

JONATHON ANGUS (Ruth's Escort/Villager) This is Jon's second show with AACT. He had a most important (albeit very small) role in last season's production of THE MUSIC MAN. He plans to spend the majority of his adult life exploring exotic lands, but for the past twenty years, Ann Arbor has been his home. Jon's fondest dramatic memories take him back to a past life, when he was working on shows with "Willy" Shakespeare back at the Globe.

KAREN BUJAK (Villager) This is Karen's first time performing with a theatre group. She's generally behind-thescenes as stagehand, prop person, dresser, and make-up person, and whatever else needs to be done. Her background includes performing with the Max Davey Singers for 11 years and teaching ballroom dancing. She has also trained in both tap and ballet.

DAVID T. BURKAM (A Strange Man/Villager) This is David's first appearance with AACT, but he started his musical-theatre career at an early age as "Winthrop" in THE MUSIC MAN in his native Ohio. David came to Ann Arbor pursuing his PhD in Math and Education at U of M, and appeared in many UMGASS productions. He has since become closely associated with The River of Understanding Ensemble, performing in AS IS and THE LAST MEETING OF THE KNIGHTS OF THE WHITE MAGNOLIA.

ANNE CANNELL (Mama Nino) is a newcomer to the Ann Arbor area. She has previously studied acting in Southfield, and is mother of four. Anne loves music, and is a genuine movie buff. She is well cast in this role, as she is a former restaurant owner.

GEOF COLLINS (Guide/Associate Editor/Policeman) most recently appeared on U of M's stage as Calaphas in JESUS CHRIST SUPERSTAR. He has appeared in AACT's THE MUSIC MAN, and LU HAMPTON LAVERTY OBERLANDER. Geof is training to be in the 1989 World Champlonship Lumberjack competition. Keep eatin' them flapjacks, Geof!

JULIE CONNOLLY (Villager) moved here from New York this summer, and is now attending Devter High School. She has appeared on Broadway in THE NIGHT OF THE STARS, played the title roll in ANNIE, Wendy in PETER PAN,

Liest in SOUND OF MUSIC, and Amaryllis in THE MUSIC MAN. She was also the New York City "Pre-Teen Talent" winner.

CHIP CUMMINGS (Frank Lippencott) Although this is Chips first show with AACT, he is no stranger to the stage, having appeared in operas, musicals and various plays since the age of 12. His credits include SOUTH PACIFIC, OKLAHOMA, ANNIE GET YOUR GUN, and AMAHL AND THE NIGHT VISITORS. Chip is recently married, active in real estate in the area, and enjoys skling and salling when he catches a glimpse of spare time.

RUTH DeBOER (Eileen) is a recent graduate of U of M's master's degree program in voice. While at the University, she was involved in productions of THE MAGIC FLUTE, LA RONDINE, and THE CORONATION OF POPPEA. This past summer she was seen in the Ohio Light Opera Company, and since has been in town, between auditions. In the future she hopes to use her musical talents in oratorio and cantata singing.

TONY FECKER (Wreck) The rambling Wreck from Trenton Tech Joins AACT this season sporting a considerable list of credits including acting as President of Dexter Community Players. Along with his set building prowess he has played leading and featured roles ranging from MOUSETRAP to THE ODD COUPLE, including BRIGADOON, LIL'ABNER, ANNIE GET YOUR GUN and PAJAMA GAME.

CARL A. FOWLKES (First Cadet/Villager) Currently a member of the U of M Arts Chorale, in his sophomore year, Carl majors in Computer Science and Musical Theatre. His interest in music is of long-standing, having been active in choir and chorale associations in his native Indiana.

VIKKI FOX (Villager) is Vice President of Dexter Community Players and teaches for Jacki Sorensen Aerobic Dance Studio. Not only is she experienced in dancing on stage, but she also lists among her credits leading roles in GUYS AND DOLLS, BRIGADOON, and LIL' ABNER, along with featured roles in FIDDLER ON THE ROOF, SOUTH PACIFIC, ANNIE GET YOUR GUN and HARVEY. She states she is "excited to be working at AACT," and we are alad to have her.

GARY "GABLE" GRAVES (Second Cadet/Villager) is currently training for a professional ballroom dance competition, and variety shows in the Detroit area. Gary is an instructor for the Ann Arbor Adult Education Program, and is in his eleventh year as a professional ballroom dance instructor. Gary lists most sports among his hobbies.

JOHN LARRY HENKEL (Policeman) has been regionally active for many years in opera, operetha, oratoria, and musical theatre Bass soloist at Kirkin-the-Hills, Bloomfield Hills, since 1970, this versatile singer-actor has appeared in numerous summer festivals, toured with repertory opera groups, and performed with many choral groups and symphony orchestras. Critically acclaimed for his opera buffo characterizations and his definitive Tevye in AACT's FIDDLER ON THE ROOF ("Henkel is a Tevye for all seasons..."), he recently appeared as Falstaff in Otto Nicolai's MERRY WIVES OF WINDSOR with the Jackson Symphony. He is a counselor at Pioneer High School.

ANGELA JONES (Villager) has served AACT for several seasons in many capacitles including Membership Chair and Make-up Chair, as well as Producer and Director. She has previously appeared on stage in ENGAGED, and most recently as Helen in BORN YESTERDAY.

CHRISTOPHER JONES (The Kid/Villager) This is Christopher's second show with AACT. He hopes to go into performing arts as a career. He is currently attending Washtenaw Community College, anticipating a transfer to a larger university.

MATRHA KREHBIEL (Villager) A former Trustee and President of the Ann Arbor Board of Education, Martha appears once again on the AACT stage, having been seen previously as Aunt Eller in OKLAHOMAI, Mare in SPOFFORD, in addition to chorus roles in CAROUSEL and PROMISES, PROMISES. Martha is also the Volunteer Coordinator for Michigan Transplant House.

NANCY KRUSE (Ruth) is seen once again by AACT audiences, some of whom may remember her performance as Gloria Thorpe in DAMN YANKESI She has studied jazz dance at Dance Theatre Studio, earned her BA in Theatre Education from MSU, and teaches Speech/Drama, English and Theatre at Manchester High School.

TOM LAYHER (Policeman/Villager) A victim of heredity (he thinks he caught the theatrical bug from his children's theatre activities in high school), he wanted to see how his kids could work so hard and have so much fun. Tom has appeared in a number of Chelsea Area Players productions, and also sings with the Ann Arbor Civic Chorus.

ED LESHER (Drunk/Villager) returns to the AACT stage in yet another series of "small parts" which now number near 30 over the last dozen years. He has also been active building the sets for many past productions. Ed is Professor Emeritus of Aerospace Engineering at U of M., and in his spare time designs, builds, and flies airplanes currently working on his third plane. LOIS LINTNER (Mrs. Wade), formerly of South Lyon, now Ann Arbor-based, is sorry that Bob Green had to feel "poorly", causing Lila Green to take her leave, and letting Lois walk into this part. But, she's absolutely delighted to be on stage again . . . one of her favorite places. Lois has done a little of everything for AACT over the years. She started as Mrs. Van Damm in THE DIARY OF ANNE FRANK, and most recently appeared as The Friend in Carol Sheldon's ZOO KEPER. During the last few years, Lois has kept in touch as an usher—and by her all-important, very efficient, Merit Award winning coordination of the AACT patrons' benefits at the Power Center. Lois spends her days at Kitchen Port.

BRIAN S. McCLEMENS (Robert Baker) has been performing in Ann Arbor for the last 6 years, including AACT's HELLO, DOLLYI and CHICAGO, and productions with UMGASS, Comic Opera Guild, and Jazz Dance Theatre. This past summer Brian performed with Eartha Kitt. Currently, Brian teaches dance at Dance Theatre Studio and Sylvia's School of Ballet.

SHEILA MCCLURE (Villager) is new to AACT, though she was active in theatrical productions during her high school days. A musical education major at EMU, she teaches flute privately, and loves music, especially teaching and performing. Also, she loves to swim.

PAUL M. MORRISON (Chick Clark) has appeared in numerous shows for Saline Area Players, Chelsea Area Players, the Goodlime Players, and has directed for the Ann Arbor Recreation Department. He has also appeared on stage as Rocky in DAMN YANKEESI and was seen most recently in THE MUSIC MAN.

JENNIFER POWELL (Villager) comes to AACT with a background steeped in varied theatrical exposures. She has sung the role of Dorabella in COSI FAN TUTI for the Opera Theatre-Aspen Music Festival, has performed at the Palace Dinner Theatre in Cripple Creek, Colorado, and at the State University of New York at Fredonia.

TRAC! PRICE (Violet) has appeared in several productions with Dexter High School and the Dexter Community Players. She is a student at Eastern Michigan University.

DAVID RUMFORD (Villager) Born and raised in Ann Arbor, David is back after many years to take over his family business (Master Furrier). He has sung with the Cincinnati May Festival Chorus for five years, including a Carnegle Hall concert. He is also singing with the U of M Choral Union. Previous stage experience includes Pat Denning in 42nd STREET with the Chelsea Area Players, and a fravelling salesman with AACT in THE MUSIC MAN.

DON SANDBERG (Valenti) Some astute listeners may recognize Don's voice from his voice-over narration on a number of PBS programs (he works at Channel 56 in Defroit). A former high school teacher, he has worked in Public Broadcasting for the past 30 years, and has served as Board Member and past Vice President for AACT. He has also been Stage Manager and performed small roles in various AACT productions.

JOHN SHULTZ (Trent/Villager) was born and raised in Plymouth. He attended college in Colorado and New York City, where he developed a great appreciation for the arts. He returned to Ann Arbor upon graduation from NYU, and has not yet left.

MARTY SMITH (Appopolous) appeared most recently in AACT's BORN YESTERDAY, INHERIT THE WIND, PLAZA SUITE, and THE DAY THE WHORES CAME OUT TO PLAY TENNIS. On other stages, he has performed in an original play, ALIENS AND SCOUNDRELS. THE ODD COUPLE for Black

Sheep Theatre and in CHAPTER TWO for the Michigan Union Summer Dinner Theater. Marty also appears in television and radio commercials, industrial films and "chameleon Street," a theatrical film scheduled for release later this year. KEVIN VOSS (Waiter) This is Kevin's first experience in nonballet theater—and with the Italian language! He has performed with the Ann Arbor Ballet Theatre and was Fritz in THE NUTCRACKER. He enjoys sports, heavy metal, and horseback riding.

WENDY WRIGHT (Helen) was last seen by AACT audiences as EulalierMacKechieShinn in THE MUSIC MAN (for which she won AACT's 1987-88 Best Supporting Actress Award). Since then she has played Lucy in YOU'RE A GOOD MAN, CHARILE BROWN, started her second year of gradual, er...graduate school, and continues to amuse and abuse her co-workers at Comerica Bank.



ABOUT THE STAFF

RICK ASHCROFT (Stage Manager) Born at a very early age in New York City, Rick took to the stage early as an actor. After peaking as the Tin Man in THE WIZARD OF OZ, he left theatre for about 15 years, becoming reinvolved as a "techie" with AACT in 1985. Since joining us, Rick has stage managed several musicals, including THE MUSIC MAN, DAMN YANKEESI and SIDE BY SIDE BY SONDHEIM. 
