





Laurie is the mother of three children and is the director of a child care program that produces a musical as part of their summer program.

ROBIN BARLOW (David Crampton) has appeared in several AACT productions, most recently as Hector Nations in FOXFIRE. He is a past President, Board Member and Treasurer of AACT. 




