The Commissioners from the Island Reach Washington.

RIOT IN BOGOTA. PANAMA, Feb. 4.-There has been a serious riot in Bogota, which lasted two days. One hundred men were killed and 500 wounded.

FOUND FROZEN STILL. WATERVILLE, Mich., Feb. 7.-A. H. Barnhart, a bachelor of temperate, industrious habits, living near here, was found in his bed yesterday frozen stiff and half his face eaten off by his pet cat.

KICKED A MAN TO DEATH. OTTUMWA, Ia., Feb. 7.-At a dance at George Sheridan's residence east of Hedrick Saturday night Harvey Bragg made an insulting remark about a young lady. Bruce Bell kicked Bragg in the stomach so that he died Sunday night. Bell is a school-teacher.

BANK MANAGER LOST \$1,000,000. BUENOS AYRES, Feb. 4.-The Banco de Roma y la Plata has suspended payment in consequence of the losses sustained in gold speculation by the manager of the concern. These losses amount to \$1,000,000.

TWIN BABIES FROZEN. KANSAS CITY, Mo., Feb. 7.-Burglars entered the house of Martin Baker in this city, chloroformed him and his wife, and in departing left a window open and Mr. Baker's two little twin babies were frozen to death.
