Entrants will receive an e-mailed confirmation one business day after AADL receives the story.	

Unless specified upon submission, all winning stories will be published on the library website. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners will be chosen from each grade. We cannot switch versions of your story if you’ve changed something after submission.
