

Imagine a word-search, but you've got to figure out the words, too! Meet the SUPER SEARCH!

In this hexagonal grid, there are 42 hidden words (forwards, backwards, or diagonally) that fall under SIX categories. Circle the answers as you find them -- like with a traditional word-search, letters can be used in multiple words.

When you are finished, there will be 13 letters that aren't used in any words, which, when written in order, will give you your final code.

Your SIX word categories (with SEVEN words each): Ivy League Colleges, Things full of holes, Trees (not including Fruit Trees), Desserts, Forms of Poems, and Characters in the Mario Universe

None of the answers are plural.

You WILL find two pieces of fruit in the puzzle. Though they TECHNICALLY could be considered trees, they are either a word in another category or a PART of a word in another category. So circle if you want, but they won't count to your SEVEN TOTAL TREES!
