Only one writer per story
Writers must be in grades 3 – 5 and attend school in Michigan
Previously submitted or published stories will not be accepted
Length: maximum 2000 words or 5 pages double-spaced
Please write your name in the e-mail message, not on your story!

In an E-mail Message Please Include:

- Writer’s Name
- Writer’s Address
- E-mail Address and/or Phone Number
- Grade & School Name (or Homeschooled)
- Story Title

Save your story as a PDF. Please do not use Google Docs.

Entrants will receive an e-mailed confirmation within 3 business days after AADL receives the story.

Unless specified upon submission, winning stories will be published on the library website. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners will be chosen from each grade. We cannot switch versions of your story if you’ve changed something after submission.
