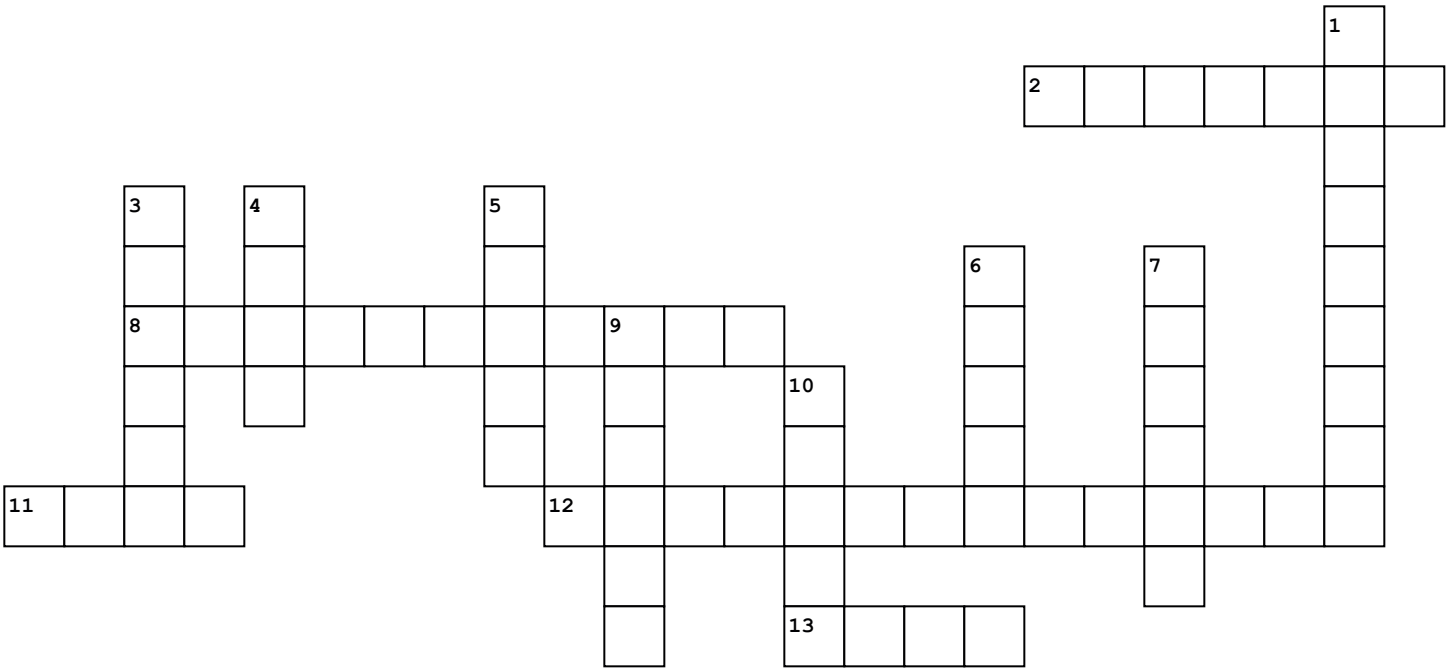


Plant Power

7. a fine, powdery substance that's often yellow that allows many plants to reproduce
9. a colorful, fragrant plant that grows almost everywhere on Earth except on glaciers!
10. these are what many plants use to absorb water from the soil and ground
