9 AM–1 PM: Sheraton Hotel 3200 Boardwalk Dr, Ann Arbor in the Michigan Room
1 PM – 4 PM: Doors closed for judging
4-6 PM: Doors open for public display of all projects
6-6:30 PM: Awards Ceremony

Prizes will be awarded in six (6) categories (the grade they are going into in the fall; with the exception of recently graduated 12th graders - they may still enter as 12th grade):

Preschool, Grades K-2, Grades 3-5, Grades 6-8, Grades 9-12 & Adults.

Prizes

Within each category there will be three winners: 1st Place, 1 Runner-up and 1 Honorable Mention.

Winners will receive gift certificates for Target in the amounts of \$50.00, \$40.00 and \$30.00 respectively.

Winners will also receive prize ribbon and custom LEGO trophies.

Prize ribbons will also be awarded in each category for the following:

Best Motorized project; Best Architectural/Engineering project; Coolest Robot; Best Vehicle; Most Creative; Best Book Related, Best Local Inspiration, Most Sophisticated, and AADL Super LEGO® Builder!

Rules:

1. Use your own LEGO® , Duplo, Megablocks or other LEGO® compatible plastic brick. The library does not provide LEGO® to enter the contest with or to play with at the contest.
2. Make your project at home, drop it off for judging and have a chance to win a prize – all in one day!
3. Entries must be your own creation, not a LEGO® designed kit, project found online, in a magazine etc.
3. One entry per participant or team where applicable.
5. Your creation must fit within a space of 24 by 24 inches. Your completed project may be no taller than four feet tall.
6. Team projects will be placed in the category of the *oldest* participant in the team. Please note that while all members of a team will receive a prize ribbon (if applicable) a team will compete for a single prize.
7. Please consider providing a sign/label with your project with your name(s), and age category. The sign should also explain the idea/inspiration for your creation to help the judges make their determinations.
8. Completed projects must be delivered to the Sheraton, on Sunday, August 4 between 9:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.
9. Judging will be conducted the afternoon of Sunday, August 4 by a team of adult LEGO® enthusiasts. The doors will open at 4:00 p.m. to allow for the entries to be viewed by the public.
10. The Awards Ceremony will begin at 6:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 4.
11. Completed entries **MUST** be taken home on the evening of Sunday, August, 4 after the ceremony ends at 6:30 p.m.
