Ald. Manly explained his vote as being on the ground that there was no legal right for boarding any of the men engaged on the sewer and also that the board of public works had no right to work the men for more than ten hours.

Ald. Wagner explained his vote on the ground that the water bill was allowed at too large an amount, owing to the shortage of water last summer.

Ald Taylor, of the Finance committee, reported the bill of Clay Greene for 1½ months rent for the city offices, \$43.74, and recommended its allowance.

Ald. Manly moved that the bill be recommitted to the Finance committee.

Ald. Martin moved that the bill be laid on the table. Adopted.

Ald. Taylor, of the Finance committee reported the bill of the Grand Rapids Lithographing Co., for \$90, for engraving sewer bonds and recommended its allowance.

draw a warrant for the sum stated therein.
