STREET GRADE RESOLUTION.

Whereas, in the opinion of the Council the grade on Eighth-st. ought to be changed and fixed and established, to the end that such street may be made

suitable for public travel and traffic. There'ore

Resolved, and it is hereby ordered that the grade on Eighth-st. from center line of W. Washington-st. to the south line of W. Huron-st. be, and the same is hereby changed from the present grade and fixed and established, so that the grade on and along such street shall be as follows, that is to say:

At the center line of W. Washington, st. 842.00 ft.

At the south line of W. Huron-st. 838.80 ft.

the elevation given being above the official city datum and along the center line of said street, and the grade lines to consist of straight lines between the several points or stations above stated—the roadway to conform thereto.
