By Ald. Schneider:

Whereas, the Street Railway Company is placing high tension feeders on

West Huron strete, contrary to the express provisions of the franchise of said company, now therefore,

Resolved, That said Street Railway Company be notified to remove said high tension wires at once.

Resolved, further, that it is the sense of this Council that unless said wires are removed within a reasonable time such proceedings by law shall be taken as may be necessary to compel the removal of the same.
