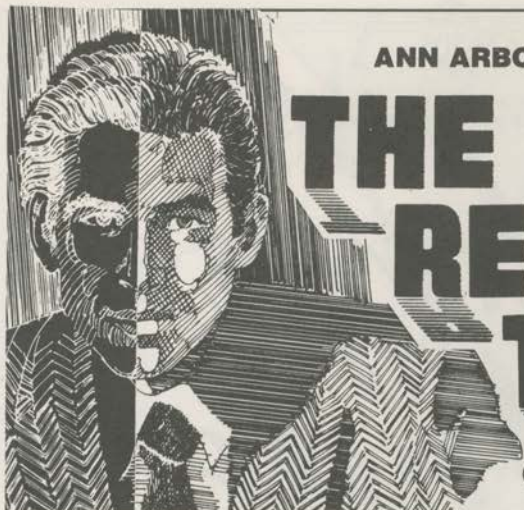

Ruth is especially prepared for her role in *PLAZA SUITE*, having spent 11 years living in New York City. She recently received her teacher's certificate and married the "man of her dreams." Cello, swimming, yoga, and running occupy her spare time.

LURIE GREIG ATWOOD (Muriel Tate) appeared in AACT's *HOW THE OTHER HALF LOVES*, for which she won best supporting actress. Other AACT credits include Carrie in *LUNCH HOUR*, Eve in *THE APPLE TREE*, and Minnie in *HELLO, DOLLY!*. Laurie recently adopted two children and is working on adopting a third. In her spare time, Laurie works on her doctorate.

JEFF CONSTAN (Waiter/Bridegroom/Borden Eisler) holds acting and directing credits from Eastern Michigan University, where he earned an M.A. in Theatre Arts. He has also sung with the Michigan Lyric Opera Company. Jeff enjoys music, writing poetry, playing guitar, and the ancient art of Tai Chi Chuan.

MARGIE COHEN (Props) appeared with AACT in *HEDDA GABLER* and *ENGAGED*, and has served on the Board of Directors. Margie is a part-time student and secretary for the University of Michigan; her spare time is spent running her mail-order business which caters to cat and dog owners.

BARBARA SMART DANIEL (Poster Designer/House Manager) has appeared in *THE SOUND OF MUSIC* and *OUR TOWN* for AACT. She has also done set dressing and assisted with props. Her main AACT task is recruiting, training, and managing a staff of up to 300 ushers for AACT MainStage productions. Barb is a professional graphics designer.

SOPHIA FARAH (Make-up) is a synonym for theatre makeup in Ann Arbor. Since 1962, she has worked on most AACT, and many School of Music Opera and Comic Opera Guild productions. She has shared her talent by teaching several workshops at AACT and Young People's Theatre.

NANCY HEUSEL (Norma Hubley) was last seen as Julie in AACT's ROYAL FAMILY. Other credits for AACT include ARSENIC AND OLD LACE, THE MIRACLE WORKER, BLITHE SPIRIT, THE LITTLE FOXES, and ON GOLDEN POND. She recently performed in JULIAN, a one-woman play about a 14th-Century religious mystic and spiritual guide. Nancy produces liturgical drama at St. Andrew's Episcopal Church and is play director at the Greenhills School.

THOM JOHNSON (Lighting Designer) directs and produces for AACT as well as designs lights and manages the stage for several AACT productions each year. He designed lights for SKIN OF OUR TEETH, directed DRACULA, appeared as Alceste in THE MISANTHROPE, and recently completed a two-year stint as President of the Board of Directors. . . among other things.

ANDY LINDSTROM (Sam Nash) has appeared in AACT's GUYS AND DOLLS, CHARLIE'S AUNT, CABARET, SHADOW BOX, BELLS ARE RINGING, AND WAS THE "Coach" in our recent DAMN YANKEESI. He has the further distinction of serving time as a "hungry and rather unsuccessful professional" for a few years in New York City Theatre back in the early 50's. Andy's passions, beside the theatre include, "Golf, Tennis, and Grandchildren."

ANNE MACLAREN (Program Editor) is a newcomer to AACT but not to theatre. She has appeared in Detroit community theatre productions of NIGHT OF JANUARY 16th and MOUSE TRAP. In addition to theatre, Anne enjoys reading fiction, swimming, biking, and travel.

BEVERLEY J. POOLEY (Roy Hubley) has been with AACT for many years and has recently appeared on stage as the devil in DAMN YANKEESI!, and as Judge Brack in HEDDA GABLER.

EMILY RANDALL (Mimsey Hubley) has been active in area theatre recently producing and directing a play for a workshop. In addition to her theatrical interests, Emily is an accomplished artist. Her work has been shown in local and upstate galleries. Other interests include sketching, writing, reading, tennis, singing, and dancing.

CHRIS and ROY SCHWARTZ (Producers) have been members of AACT since 1970, working in almost every aspect of theatre. Chris served on the Board of Directors and was president one year. Roy's major areas of endeavor have been lighting and set design. This show marks their first collaboration as producers.

KENDRA SCHWARTZ (Assistant to the Producers) has ushered for AACT productions, and has been a "helper" around the AACT building since 1979 when we moved to Main St. She has since ushered and helped tear down sets. Kendra appeared in drama workshop scenes from HEIDI at school; but this is her first official work for AACT MainStage.

MARTY SMITH (Jesse Kiplinger) marks his fourth appearance in a Neil Simon play with PLAZA SUITE. He played Oscar Madison in THE ODD COUPLE at the Blacksheep Theatre; George Schneider in CHAPTER TWO for the Michigan Union Summer Dinner Theatre; and multiple roles in AACT's THE GOOD DOCTOR. His last AACT appearance was as Ross, the conniving art dealer in THE LATE CHRISTOPHER BEAN. He has also appeared in industrial training films for Domino's, Ford, and other companies, and in radio commercials.

PHYLLIS WRIGHT (Karen Nash) has appeared in THE ROYAL FAMILY, JANUS, THE BARRETT'S OF WIMPOLE STREET, MAJOR BARBARA, and THE LATE CHRISTOPHER BEAN with AACT. An ardent supporter of the Arts, Phyllis serves on the Board of Directors of the AACT, is a Trustee for the Ann Arbor Summer Festival and a docent for the University of Michigan Museum of Art.

DANNY YOUNG (Bellhop) last appeared with AACT in FIFTH OF JULY. Danny holds a fine arts degree from Western Michigan University and has appeared in many University productions. He has performed professionally throughout the Kalamazoo and Detroit areas.

JEFF ZUPAN (Set Designer) worked on the set crews for DAMN YANKEES! and ROMANTIC COMEDY at AACT before tackling this, his first project as set designer. His theatre career began 20 years ago at a community theatre in Berea, Ohio, where he worked on the technical crew. After a 14 year hiatus from the theatre, Jeff picked up his interest again four years ago and joined AACT.
