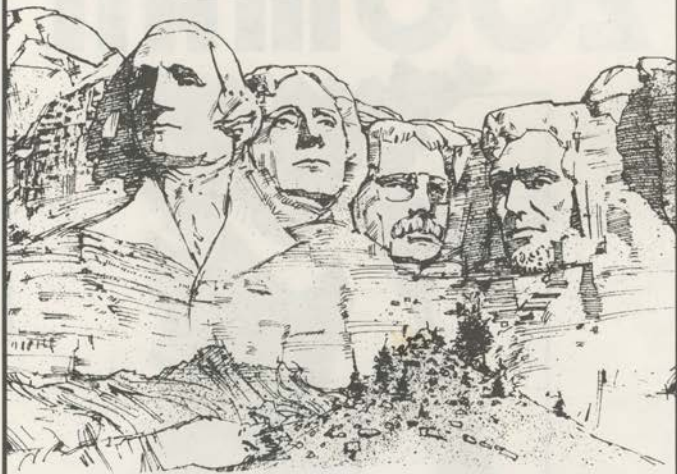

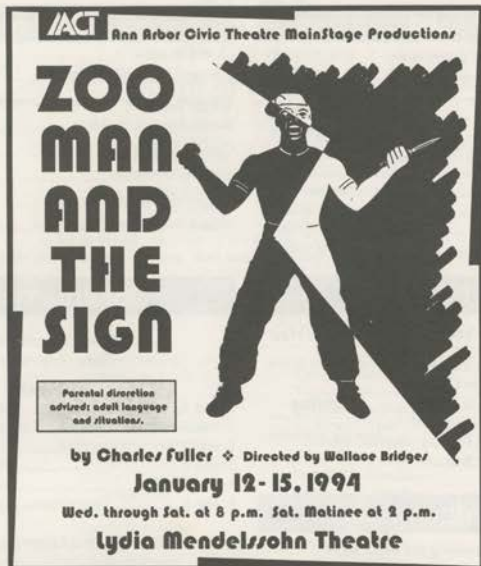

"The killers of my daughter Jenny are free on the streets because my neighbors will not identify them."

- Reuben's sign in Zooman and the Sign -

On Monday, December 6 in a New York subway car, Collin Ferguson methodically shot and killed passengers who were commuting from the safety of the suburbs. This horrendous incident reinforces the importance of society's need to unify in action against the conditions that foster such random acts of violence.

Those suburban passengers may have felt insulated against that sort of violence and therefore never thought to act against it until it came crashing down upon them. Perhaps they sought artificial refuge in the perception that those random acts of violence are limited to the inner city and minority groups. Ask yourself, "Is it easier to perceive a character like Zooman as a member of a minority group rather than a Caucasian?" This production of Zooman and the Sign forces you to consider that question. Where do you stand on the issue?

"If society wants to end the senseless violence that is man's inhumanity to man, then, we must join together in taking decisive action to erase the conditions which foster the perpetrators."


