Curtiz received an Oscar nomination for directing.

1941. Starring Edward G. Robinson, John Garfield, Ida Lupino. This is the famous Jack London story of a brutal captain on a mysterious ship who tries to destroy all around him when he realizes he is going blind. A really terrifying film.

1943. Starring Bogart, Peter Lorre, Sydney Greenstreet. Sam plays it once again in this classic of intrigue in Boglie's casino in Northern Africa. Academy Awards and everything else.
